Calcium Sulfate used in fertilizer is intended to prevent and correct calcium deficiency in crops. Calcium is an essential nutrient for plants, as they need it to build cell walls and properly grow. Signs of a calcium deficiency in plants can be noticed through yellowing leaves, a decrease in seed growth, and a decrease in the size and quality of the crop. Calcium Sulfate as a fertilizer improves soil quality, stabilizes the movement of water through the soil, and supports crop longevity.
